Venues and Hotels

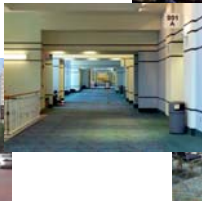
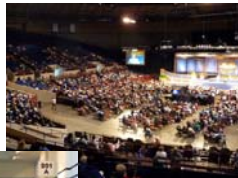


- All event activities are planned to take place in the Downtown Fort Worth. Participants will be able to walk to the venue, hotels, restaurants, theatres, museums, etc.

- The Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport is approximately 20 minutes from downtown Fort Worth, Hotels and the Venue.



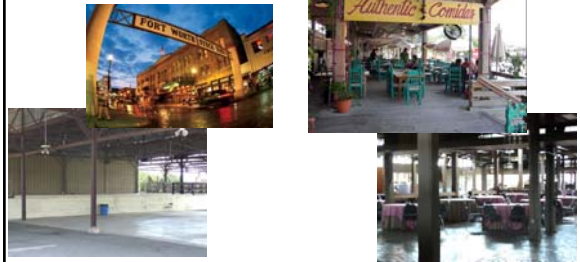

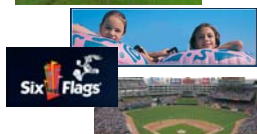
